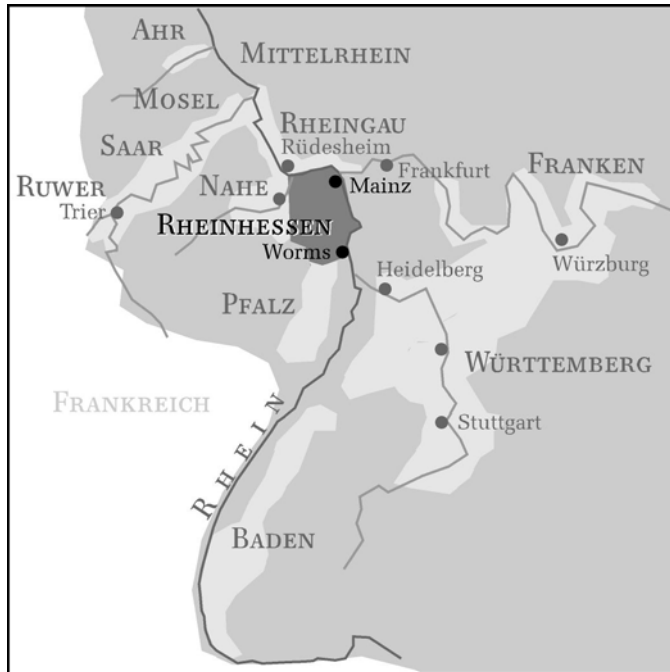


P.J. Valckenberg - Rheinhessen



- Wine:** VALCKENBERG MADONNA Kabinett MA2-07
- Producer:** Founded in 1786, the House of P.J. Valckenberg in Worms has more than two centuries of experience in bottling and exporting fine German wines
- Region / Vineyards:** Rheinhessen, Germany's largest wine region with its gentle rolling hills, is situated in the climatically favored large elbow formed by the Rhine river as it flows from Worms to its sweeping bend around Mainz and west to its next turn at Bingen.
- MADONNA:** With the purchase of the major portion of the original "Liebfrauenmilch" vineyard in 1808, Peter Joseph Valckenberg became not only the first private owner and producer of what was already a very popular wine, but also the first significant exporter of German wines. Valckenberg's MADONNA is still exported worldwide and is the leading brand in this category in several markets today.
- Taste Profile:** Kabinett is the first of the six subcategories of quality wines with Prädikat. These wines are therefore usually the lightest and driest of the Prädikat wines. They come from fully ripe grapes. The greater ripeness of the grapes and the slightly higher sweetness compared to MADONNA QbA add to the wine's expressive fruitiness, intensive floral bouquet and underlying herbal character.
- Pairings:** The delicate sweetness together with a rather mild acidity make this wine an ideal companion for dinner and a wide variety of foods.
- Wine Profile:** Alc. by Vol.: 10.0 %, residual sugar: 3.63 % (36.3g/l), acidity: 0.65 % (6.5 g/l)
A skillfully crafted cuvée of the traditional grape varieties Riesling, Müller-Thurgau, Silvaner and Kerner.
