

Bernkasteler Badstube Riesling Kabinett 2017




Producer

The famous wine estate Joh. Jos. Prüm was founded in 1911 in Wehlen, on the Mosel. It is one of the most unique white wine producers in Germany.

Vintage report

After an early start of the vegetation, a cold period in April and May with frosty nights interrupted the speedy start of the season and caused losses in some vineyards. The warm, sunny weather that followed up pushed the growing again in May till mid of July. In September, the ripening process slowed down by a humid, cool period. A golden October allowed well ripened grapes from Kabinett to TBA concentration to be harvested early, at very fortunate weather conditions.

Characteristics

-  rich fruit, white stonefruits
-  mineral, balanced and refreshing Riesling
-  spicy dishes, dessert wine with strong cheese

Facts

- Grape Variety** Riesling
- Terroir** Bernkasteler Badstube vineyards border on Graacher Himmelreich, but Badstube is more westwards and less steep; consequently the vines face less sun in the morning and they are lighter in the taste; weather-beaten grey slate soil
- Appellation** Mosel
- Vinifikation** grapes are all hand-picked, predominantly single pale, fermentation with wild yeast
