

Graacher Himmelreich Riesling Auslese Gold Cap 2015




Producer

The famous wine estate Joh. Jos. Prüm was founded in 1911 in Wehlen, on the Mosel. It is one of the most unique white wine producers in Germany.

Vintage report

After a very mild winter, bud break took place in the second half of April, slightly earlier than normal. Both May and June brought wild fluctuations in temperature – from plenty of rain to a hot summer. The weather turned significantly cooler in September, which was very helpful in preventing the grapes from rot. October was also cool, but rather dry, which created perfect conditions for harvest. They started picking in early October and finished on November 4th.

Characteristics

-  sweet aromas of stone fruits
-  elegant, well-balanced, refreshing acidity, delicate minerality
-  aperitif, goes well with Asian cuisine or many richer courses

Facts

- Grape Variety Riesling
- Terroir Graacher Himmelreich (“Kingdom of heaven in the village of Grach) faced more westwards, little less steep and deeper soils than Wehlener Sonnenuhr, weather-beaten grey slate soil with good water reservoirs
- Appellation Mosel
- Vinifikation Picked by hand; predominantly single pale; fermentation in stainless steel tanks with wild yeast.
