

Zeltinger Sonnenuhr Riesling Auslese 2015




Producer

The famous wine estate Joh. Jos. Prüm was founded in 1911 in Wehlen, on the Mosel. It is one of the most unique white wine producers in Germany.

Vintage report

After a very mild winter, bud break took place in the second half of April, slightly earlier than normal. Both May and June brought wild fluctuations in temperature – from plenty of rain to a hot summer. The weather turned significantly cooler in September, which was very helpful in preventing the grapes from rot. October was also cool, but rather dry, which created perfect conditions for harvest. They started picking in early October and finished on November 4th.

Characteristics

-  fruity, floral
-  very complex, dense minerality, lower acidity and more austere than Wehlener Sonnenuhr
-  spicy cuisine, dessert wine

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| Grape Variety | Riesling |
| Terroir | Zeltinger Sonnenuhr, sun-exposed location; less steep than Wehlener Sonnenuhr and their roots are more challenged by hitting the slate rock sooner |
| Appellation | Mosel |
| Vinifikation | Grapes picked by hand, single pale; fermentation in stainless steel tanks with wild yeast |
