Vintage report

The main harvest started on September 26, concluding on October 11. Due to the rapid ripening and the threat of overripeness, a selective harvest of healthy grapes was extremely important. This resulted in decreasing yields throughout the harvest. On average, we harvested 20% less than in previous years. Nevertheless, we were very satisfied with the qualities of the Riesling grapes that made it into the cellars. Fortunately, we experienced only half a day of rain throughout the entire harvest period, leaving us contentedly anticipating the upcoming vintage.
