

Vintage report

2015 was marked by weather extremes in the Rheingau. Flowering began on June 8th. Repeated heat waves with record-breaking maximum temperatures were only briefly interrupted by cool periods during the long, hot summer. One advantage of the drought, though, was that hardly any diseases, fungus, or pests could take hold. The grapes began the maturing process on August 15th, and the main harvest at our estate began in early October, with pleasingly high must weights. It remained dry and sunny the entire month of October— perfect harvest weather.
