Vintage report

The wine vintage of 2022 was marked by high temperatures and extreme dryness. From September 22nd, we started the manual harvest of Riesling grapes with our diligent harvest team. Grapes of fine maturity with good quality were harvested until October 16th. The crowning achievement was the harvest of overripe grapes in the Johannisberger Hölle and Rudesheimer Berg Rottland locations. Overall, the major concerns about the 2022 vintage did not materialize. We had no problems with excessively high alcohol levels, no too low acidity levels, and the quantity was within the 10-year average.
