Vintage report

The 2023 wine year in Rheinhessen began with mild temperatures, which were crucial for a successful flowering in early June. The year was characterized by initially severe drought and subsequent rain shortly before the harvest, but also increased fungal pressure, to which the winegrowers had to react quickly and with precise selection. For grape varieties such as Dornfelder and Portugieser, harvesting also had to begin particularly early, with the grape harvest finishing at the end of September.
