Vintage report

2021 brought a year full of challenges. Despite the heavy rainfall, the summer went very well and the grapes were also developing well. As in the rest of the country, the wetness bothered us. They started harvesting the basic sparkling wine on September 20, 2021. Sorting and cutting out a lot was the order of the day. We are very satisfied with the quality of the harvested grapes and look forward to a very unique vintage that will differ from previous years.
