Vintage report

The main harvest started on September 26, concluding on October 11. Due to the rapid ripening and the threat of overripeness, a selective harvest of healthy grapes was extremely important. This resulted in decreasing yields throughout the harvest. The crowning achievement was the harvest of two fantastic Trockenbeereauslesen, which are now spending ample time in our cellars to fully develop their potential.
