Vintage report

The 2024 wine year in the Pfalz region of Germany was marked by a mixture of weather challenges and promising quality. Known for its moderate climate, the Pfalz is one of Germany's most important wine regions, particularly recognized for its white wines, including Riesling, as well as red wines like Pinot Noir. Riesling, in particular, thrived in the cooler conditions of 2024, resulting in wines that are expected to have a good balance of fruitiness and freshness. For red wines, particularly Pinot Noir, the harvest was slightly more challenging due to the fluctuating temperatures.
