



Westhofen Morstein Dry Riesling dry 2023

Grape Variety	Riesling
Terroir	The Morstein vineyard in nearby Westhofen enjoys a worldwide reputation. Our twelve-year-old Riesling vines grow on a light layer of loess with underlying limestone rock.
Appellation	Rheinhessen
Vinifikation	Due to the rather high location of our plot, we achieve maximum ripening delay and thus finely balanced aromas in the grapes and in the wine.
