From the 1 ha that Ewald Kopp started with in 1996, the winery has grown to 32 hectares of selected vineyards in the best locations in the Ortenau region. Johannes Kopp took over the winery at the age of 22.


### Vintage report


The year 2024 was characterized by weather extremes of all kinds. At the very beginning of the growing season in April, nearly all German wine regions experienced a severe frost event, from which we were not spared. Harvest began later than in previous years, on September 9th, 2024. Remarkably, despite the heavy rains throughout the year, the berries remained small and concentrated. This exceptional quality was evident both during fermentation and in the first tastings of the young wines in November. A small but outstanding vintage that impresses with freshness, pronounced minerality, depth, and elegance. The moderate alcohol levels complete the excellent overall picture of this unique vintage.
