

## Johannisberg 'Riesling "Dry Auf der Höll" 1st Growth 2024

### Producer

The traditional estate is owned by the Eser family and located in the Rheingau region. They're a member of the VDP association and the CHARTA group.

### Vintage report

We began the Riesling harvest on September 30th and successfully completed it on October 15th. Through selective harvesting, we were able to produce fine Estate Rieslings, elegant Village Wines, and expressive Erste and Große Lage wines. However, due to the absence of botrytis, we didn't get the chance to harvest noble sweet qualities this year.
