Terroir            The name "Hölle" which could be literally translated as "hell" is derived from the middle German word "Halde". That means steep hill and has nothing to do with the name hell. The vines, which are about 25 years old, grow on a very heavy clayey soil. Thus, the wines always appear monumental,
