Terroir	fertile soils to produce high quality grapes

Vinifikation	Harmonious cuvee of carefully selected high-quality basic wines; classic fermentation on the bottle, pressure exerted by the carbonic acid needs to amount to at least 3.5 bar – up to 6 bar; matures on its yeast for a minimum of 9 months
