Producer

The "Undone brand" is owned by the tradehouse Valckenberg and represents in the white wine segment a fruity, lively Riesling and a Pinot Noir for the red wine lovers with dark red fruit aroma.

Vintage report

Germany's largest wine growing area "Rheinhessen" has been affected for the second year with really warm weather. The vines sprouted a week earlier than normal, but the process slowed due to a cool May. June accelerated the growth again and the grapes have been affected by sunburn. The main harvest was finished within three weeks and lasted until the beginning of October. The late summer weather produced very healthy and ripe grapes.

Characteristics

-  fresh cherry nose, kinda tart cherry, light strawberry
-  very smooth with berry and plum notes
-  salmon, red meat, and pasta.

Facts

- Grape Variety** Pinot Noir
- Terroir** This region with its gentle rolling hills, is situated in the climatically favored large elbow formed by the Rhine river as it flows from Worms to its sweeping bend around Mainz and west to its next turn at Bingen.
- Appellation** Rheinhessen
- Vinifikation** This wine was fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks, so it has no oak influence.
