
Producer

The "Undone brand" is owned by the tradehouse Valckenberg and represents in the white wine segment a fruity, lively Riesling and a Pinot Noir for the red wine lovers with dark red fruit aroma.

Vintage report

"A roller coaster ride" was how the year's progression was described and steady nerves were required. The weather gods showed themselves to be more kind during the extremely early harvest following heavy rains. The mild weather with its cold nights helped many grapes evolve to a good level of ripeness and plenty of aromas. The young wines in Rheinhessen are proving to be very fruit-driven with a well-balanced, refreshing acidity. Especially the late-ripening varieties such as Riesling benefitted from this challenging vintage.

Characteristics

-  fresh cherry nose, kinda tart cherry, light strawberry
-  very smooth with berry and plum notes.
-  red meat, and pasta.

Terroir	This region with its gentle rolling hills, is situated in the climatically favored large elbow formed by the Rhine river as it flows from Worms to its sweeping bend around Mainz and west to its next turn at Bingen.

Vinifikation	Fermentation and ageing in stainless steel tanks, no oak influence.
