Vintage report

Harvest was the earliest ever and the smallest in volume for half a century. The April frosts affected almost a third of the region's vineyards. The summer brought warm, dry weather, heavy rain, and isolated hailstorms. Picking started in mid-September. Riesling grapes harvested later were able to profit from the favorable weather conditions in the second half of September. This resulted in good must weights and fruit acidity levels.
