Producer

The winery was established in 1875 by Dr. Robert Weil and is located in Kiedrich, which is in the wine region Rheingau. The estate philosophy, to compare modern style with old traditions, is reflected in the winemaking.

Vintage report

2019 had its own very hot and especially parched tale to tell. Above average temperatures and warm, dry soils at the beginning of the year led to a very early budbreak. A wonderful ripening period rewarded us with optimally healthy and intensely delicious grapes, and a harvest in phenomenal weather starting in the second half of September. Looking back, 2019 was certainly a demanding vintage. Yet it was also one that rewarded our constant labors in the vineyard with stunning, healthy and high-quality fruit, the foundation for long-lived wines.
