Producer

The Neipperg family owns 32 hectares located in the wineregion Württemberg, which are divided in three monopole sites: Neipperger Schlossberg, Schwaigerner Ruthe and Klingenberg Schlossberg.

Vintage report

The 2019 vintage mirrors the 2014 and 2016 vintages- after an early budbreak, vegetation was somewhat slowed by a cool May. The harvest began at Neipperg on September 16. The good water supply of August and September allowed a satisfactory harvest in quantity and quality.

-  soft tobacco and roasting aroma, complex and harmonious tannins
-  roasted fish and game, please decant before enjoying
