Vintage report

A warm March was responsible for early bud breaks, which were damaged after frosty nights in April. Blossoming started in June, after a warm, sunny May. After a wind storm on the 1st of August and wet days, followed an early harvest to save the small amount of healthy grapes.

-  green plum flavor, crushed minerals, undertone of bramble
