### Producer

The estate in Palatine was established in 1994 by the Schneider family in Ellerstadt. Today Markus Schneider cultivates 90 hectares and established his wines worldwide.

### Vintage report

Budbreak and flowering each corresponded perfectly with the longstanding averages, although July and August then brought a long, dry stretch to the vines in the Pfalz. Again, after a very hot summer, the harvest team was very happy to pick the grapes with a perfect ripeness. Rich aromas and such a grateful vintage are in comparison to the last one.

### Characteristics

-  tropical fruit aromas
-  mango, peach, apricot, tight and citrusy
-  spicy Asian cuisine, poultry, fish dishes

- Terroir             Friedelsheimer Schloss/castle, sun-exposed location, lime sandstone soil
- Appellation       Palatinate
- Vinifikation       Gentle pressing with 6-8-hour maceration. Without fining, fermentation in stainless steel started with natural yeast.
