



Bienenberg Spätburgunder Great Growth dry 2019

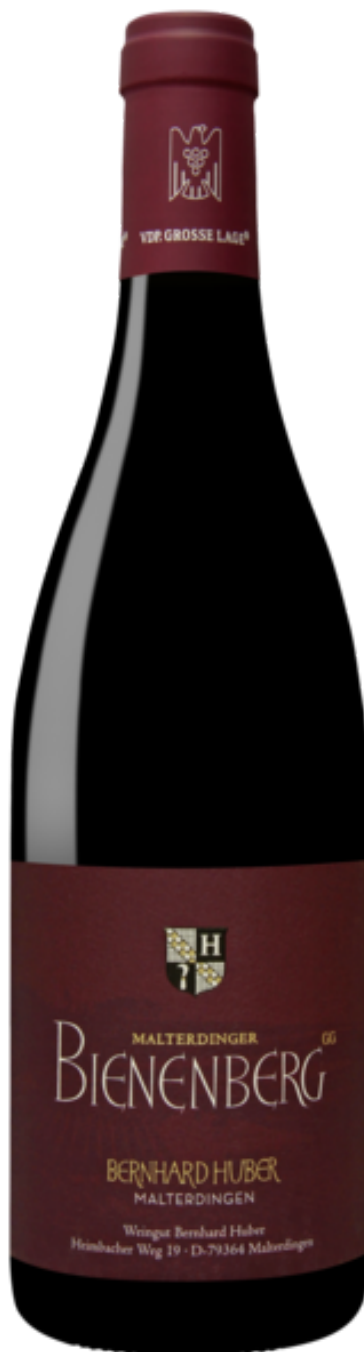
