



# Juliusspital Müller-Thurgau 2020

### Producer

The oldest wine cellar in Würzburg, dating from 1576 with its 250 metre long corridor, is still the heart of the wine production in the Juliusspital. In the large wooden barrels, 220 in total, mature wines from the most valuable vineyards in Franconia.

#### Vintage report

The 2020 vintage shows healthy and high quality grapes. Due to favorable weather conditions, we can expect juicy, succulent and tangy wines with a pleasant acidity and a fantastic variety of flavors. With about 30% less than the average vintage, they have another small amount of wine in our cellars for the second year in a row.
