The traditional estate is owned by the Eser family and located in the Rheingau region. They're a member of the VDP association and the CHARTA group.


Vintage report

Vintage 2014 was harvested end of September, i.e. very early due to the far developed ripeness of Riesling grapes. The crop had to be very efficient and pressed for time to avoid any problems caused by rot. Elevated temperature for the season and high humidity are not the best conditions for harvest time. The strict selection of grapes yielded a very low crop but throughout at good qualities up to Spätlese.

Characteristics

 elderflower, white pepper, floral notes.

 slightly sweet, tangy acidity, long finish.
