Jahrgangsbericht

Vintage 2015 was characterized by a long period of drought in the summer coupled with an extreme heat wave. The result was a smaller berry size. Although this meant lower quantity, the quality was superb, as the smaller berries were very concentrated and healthy, with a high Oechsle level. A dry autumn with cool mornings made for ideal harvest conditions. 2015 belongs, undoubtedly, among the top vintages at the estate (along with 2011, 2009, and 2003) and maybe even better.

Charaktereigenschaften

-  black berries, cherries, cinnamon
-  powerful with a good structure, hearty but balanced tannins, long finish
-  hearty dishes, mediterranean grilled meat, goat cheese

Terroir	Sourced from vineyards neighbouring their top sites, a typical Lemberger that reflects the unique terroir of the region. Keuper soil, southern slope exposure
Appellation	Württemberg
Vinifikation	Selective hand-harvesting, careful transportation and treatment, 14 days fermentation on skins. Aging in big wooden barrels
